

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Executed by the undersigned for the purpose of forming a Wisconsin corporation under Chapter 181 of the Wisconsin statutes, WITHOUT STOCK AND NOT FOR PROFIT.

INSTRUCTIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

- 1. Article 1. The name MUST contain "Corporation," "Incorporated," or "Limited," or the abbreviation of one of those words.
 - 2. Article 2. Insert "perpetual" or insert any limitation desired.
 - 3. Article 3. Must show definite purposes.

(The statute expressly states that it is NOT necessary to enumerate the powers.)

- 4. Articles 5 and 6. The corporation MUST have a registered agent.
- 5. Article 7. This article may be stricken if desired. In that case, the number of directors will remain as shown in article 8.
- 6. Article 10. This article must set out the method of accepting and discharging members, any denial or restriction of voting rights, any classification of members (including distinguishing features of each class), OR the article must authorize the by-laws to cover these matters.
